Job Summary

We are seeking a passionate and experienced Epee Fencing Coach to join our team and help lead our fencing program. The ideal candidate will be responsible for developing fencers of all ages and skill levels, fostering a love for the sport, and promoting sportsmanship.

Responsibilities

- Design, develop, and implement training sessions tailored to different age groups and skill levels (beginner, intermediate, advanced).
- Instruct on proper fencing technique, including footwork, bladework, and tactics for epee.
- Provide individualized instruction and feedback to help fencers improve their skills and achieve their goals.
- Ensure a safe and positive learning environment for all participants.
- Motivate and inspire fencers to reach their full potential.
- Develop competition strategies for individual fencers and teams.
- Help with local and regional fencing tournaments hosted by OFC.
